T.C.S SENIOR BOYS DENIED BY LATE CARNEW CHARGE!!

In what was an entertaining game with free following attacking football throughout, the Tullow C.S Senior boys succumbed to a late surge from Colasite Bhríde Carnew to lose out on a very tight competitive affair.

The game had a lively start with the teams exchanging a brace of points each. Carnew drew first blood with a quick fire point but Tullow responded well with a free from full forward Cian Gorman Comerford and a point from corner forward Shane Cormican before a well worked move lead to a point from Carnew midfielder Ciaran Lambert to leave the sides level. The defining moment of the first half soon followed do when Tullow were awarded a penalty and centre forward Tadhg Hutton stepped up to coolly slot it home. Cathal Healy was on hand for Tullow soon after with a well taken point to stretch the Tullow lead to 1-3 to 2 points. Carnew rallied well do with three points from midfielder Dan Redmond and Tullow had the crossbar and a couple of fine saves from keeper Conor Elliot to thank for denying a Carnew goal. Another Carnew point just before the break left the scoreline level at 1-3 to 6 points as the halftime whistle blew.

The T.C.S boys came out of the blocks quick in the second half with points from Cian Gorman Comerford & Cathal Healy quickly to extend their lead. A flurry of scores soon followed with both

teams exchanging points at either end of the field. Three points for Carnew were answered with three points for Tullow through a frantic 10 minute period and bookended by a fine score from Carnew midfielder Ciaran Lambert to leave the tie perfectly balanced 1-8 to 11 points as the game approached the final minutes. It was the boys from Colaiste Bhríde who finished strongest do when corner forward Jake O Dwyer added a goal and a point in quick succession to nudge his team into a 4 point lead. Tullow battled hard to respond but when substitute Joe McGuicklan found the net in the dying seconds of the game it sealed the win for the visitors.

Tullow C.S coach Mr O Shea was delighted with his teams performance saying “It was a very close contest all the way through the game. It was very close. Carnew scored a goal in the last few minutes that secured the game. Both teams were very well matched” . Mr O Shea also highlighted an excellent performance by Cathal Healy who was his TCS player of the match.
