A penalty from Daniel Haskins extended the Tullow lead before Darragh Corcoran went over for an unbelieveable individual try breaking from deep in his own half to barrel throught the Kilcullen lines and give Tullow a 24-12 lead as the game approached the closing stages. The game was sealed for T.C.S when center Daire Byrne got the final try of the game and Dan Haskins was on target again from the boot to give Tullow a well deserved 31-17 win and send them through to the Leinster Semi- Final.
